



## How You Can Help the Animals

**Provide a permanent or temporary (foster) loving home for an animal** – we'll help you find the right new family member, provide all the information you need, and even offer you a discount on puppy and dog training classes. ## How You Can Help Build “Our Friends New Home”

*Friends For the Dearborn Animal Shelter* (the *Friends*) have undertaken the completion of a new “green” (environmentally-friendly) animal shelter and education facility in partnership with the City of Dearborn. The existing facility is out-dated (poor air exchange, poor sewage disposal, porous housing materials); too small to house the volume of animals and to accommodate a positive experience for visitors, volunteers, and staff; and is inconveniently located. The planned new facility is being located, on the property south of the Henry Ford Centennial Library, and designed to alleviate these issues. This major capital fund raising campaign of private, corporate, and foundation funds is to obtain the estimated \$4 million needed for construction and \$1 million endowment goal. The New Shelter Endowment Fund will be funded at the rate of twenty five cents from every dollar of new shelter capital campaign revenue. These restricted funds will be invested in socially responsible instruments. All interest income earned on new shelter fund balances shall be restricted to use only for new shelter activities.
